



## Albert G. Knoll

March 26, 1937 - November 22, 2013

Albert Knoll, 76, of Chambersburg, passed away at home on Friday, November 22, 2013. He was born March 26, 1937 in Chambersburg, the son of the late George and Helen (Smith) Knoll.

A lifetime member of Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church, an Eagle Scout and a 1955 graduate of CASHS, he holds a Master's degree in Social Studies from Shippensburg State College. Al was an educator for 37 years and retired from Fannett-Metal H.S. in 1995. He was listed in Who's Who Among American Teachers, he was truly a teacher from the heart.

He also served as a senior instructor in the 209th Officer Academy with the United States Army Reserves. He retired in 1997 as a Master Sergeant, having served faithfully and honorably for 24 years.
