



## Barry L. Shetter

February 8, 1955 - March 24, 2016

Our much loved Barry Lynn Shetter, age 61, passed away peacefully at home in Carlisle PA on March 24th, 2016 after a courageous battle with ALS. He was born on February 8th, 1955 in Chambersburg PA, son of the late Huber D. Shetter and Janet E. (Wenger) Shetter.

Barry was a graduate of Chambersburg High School where he excelled in baseball and basketball and went on to play for Basketball for Lycoming College, graduating with a B.A. in Biology in 1977. He did graduate studies at Penn State University. Barry retired from F&M Trust of Chambersburg, as Assistant Vice President of Facilities, after 25 years of service. He was an active member of the Central PA Chapter of the International Facilities Managers Association and the Chambersburg YMCA.
