Charles Louis (C) Griffin, 53, passed away unexpectedly at his home on July 13. He was born in Lebanon, Pennsylvania, to Charles M. and Marilyn Endrizzi Griffin. He was a 1990 graduate of Chambersburg Area Senior High School, and attended Berklee College of Music, Boston, majoring in Music Synthesis. Music was important in his life, and he enjoyed composing and creating music.
