



## Charles S "Sonny" Upperman

January 12, 1934 - April 11, 2016

Charles S. "Sonny" Upperman, 82 , of Chambersburg passed away on Monday, April 11, 2016 at home. He was born on January 12, 1934 in Chambersburg, the son of the late Charles and Ada (Hocker) Upperman. He was a 1951 graduate of CASHS, a long time member of the Bethel Assembly of God Church where he was a Royal Ranger Leader, a past member of the George Washington Masonic Lodge and the Shreiners Zembo Temple.
