Dawn Anthony Stoudt, 90, of Scotland, Pennsylvania, died Tuesday afternoon July 4th, 2023 surrounded by family and friends.

Dawn was the first born to William B. Anthony and Marian Evans Anthony, on November 23, 1932, where her family resided in Strausstown, Pennsylvania.
