



## Dorothy Zimmerman Yoh (Zimmerman)

June 12, 1921 - September 25, 2017

Mrs. Dorothy "Dottie" June (Zimmerman) Yoh, age 96, of Chambersburg, PA died September 25, 2017 peacefully at home.
