Efraim Capestany, 79 of Chambersburg, passed away on Wednesday, November 28, 2018 at home. He was born on August 13, 1939 in San Juan, the son of the late Mario and Julia (Marrero) Capestany. He was a photographer, inventor and started off in a studio in the Bronx as a framer and artist, teaching, doing portraits and still life. He went on to become a noted for his art restoration. He was a member of the American Institute for Conservation and the International Institute for Historical and Artistic Works in London. Efraim served his country in the US Army during the Korean Conflict. Surviving are three daughters, two grandchildren and many nieces and nephews. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife Catherine Capestany and six siblings. The Funeral will be held 2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, December 4, 2018 at Sellers Funeral Home.
