



Emma Jane Reasner (Kaiser)

January 29, 1923 - August 24, 2014

Jane K. Reasner, 91, of Fayetteville passed away on Sunday, August 24, 2014 in the Chambersburg Hospital. She was born January 29, 1923 in Mont Alto, PA, the daughter of the late Lawrence D. and Hazel L. (Carbaugh) Kaiser.

She started school in a one-room schoolhouse in Altwalt, PA then went to Duffield School, Fayetteville Consolidated School, graduating in 1941 from Chambersburg High School. She worked part-time at McCroy's for several years also at the Montgomery store part-time, then full-time at the former Stanley company several times, at Franklin County Courthouse for four years in the treasurer's office for William O. Shuman, two years at Chambersburg Hospital as a secretary for Frank O' Brien, Administrator, then joined her husband in Reasner's Paving and Excavating-also at Reasner's Garage. After selling the Excavating and Paving and Reasner's Garage, she joined her son at Reasner's Burial Vault business but when he expanded to Chambersburg Burial Vaults, she retired. Her volunteer work included Contact and a Chambersburg Greeter with Senior City Tax Work. Jane was a member of Calvary United Methodist Church of Fayetteville (formerly: Fayetteville Methodist Church) since 1936, when she joined at the age of 13; she was a former member of Amaranth Lodge, American Business women , a stock group, and a volunteer with American Lung Assoc., Christmas Seals and the American Cancer Society. She was also a life member of the Fayetteville Volunteer Fire Department Co. 7 Auxiliary and a social member of Charles

Nitterhouse V. F. W. Post #1599 and Bert J. Asper Post #46 of the American Legion. She is survived by her son, L. Anthony Reasner; one grandson: Tony R. Reasner and his wife Gretchen, one granddaughter: Megan; one great-grandson: Ethan, all from Oklahoma; two brothers: Lawrence D. Kaiser and Ronald Kaiser. She is preceded in death by her husband: Hammett B. Reasner who died on March 27, 1985.
