



Frances Parmer (Blubaugh)

Frances Ruth Parmer, of 867 Broad Street, Chambersburg, PA, passed away on Saturday morning, August 31, 2013, in the Chambersburg Hospital.

Born December 31, 1922, in Washington Township, PA, she was the daughter of the late Daniel Shefford Blubaugh and Minnie Savilla (Utz) Blubaugh.
