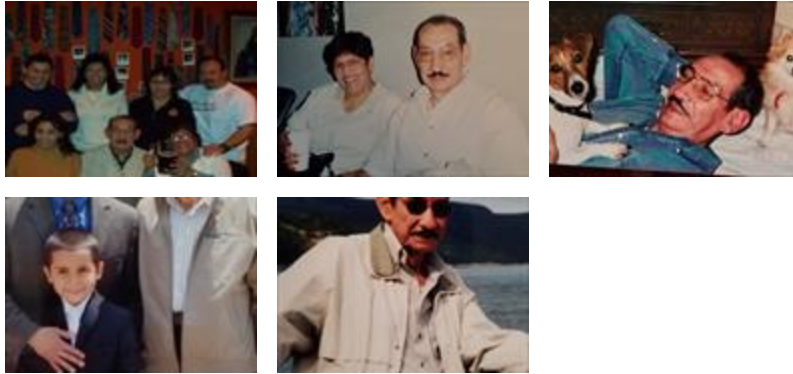
He is preceded in death by his parents, and his two older sisters and older brother.
