Gerald Andrew Yaukey, 89, of Frederick, Maryland, passed away peacefully on May 12, 2026, at Seaton Assisted Living in Hagerstown, with his sons by his side. He was the beloved husband of the late Janet Heckman Yaukey. Gerald and Janet were married November 9, 1957.

Born June 2, 1936, in Chambersburg, Pennsylvania, he was the son of the late Crawford L. Yaukey and Blanche Peters Yaukey.

Gerald graduated from Chambersburg High School and attended Penn State Mont Alto, where he earned a two-year degree in electrical engineering.
