Jan Melvin Wolgemuth, 88, of Chambersburg, PA passed away peacefully on December 26, 2024, at the Mercy House in Chambersburg.

Born September 18, 1936, in Manheim, Lancaster County, PA, he was the son of the late Anna Verna Wolgemuth (Shirk) and Melvin Lehman Wolgemuth. His stepmother was the late Dorothy Wolgemuth of Green Cove Springs, FL.
