Jerry B. Ashway, 73 of Chambersburg passed away at home on Wed., April 22, 2015. He was born Sept. 29, 1941 in Chambersburg, the son of the late Henry Denton and Mildred (Brown) Ashway Jr. He was a long time member of Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church where he was an usher for many years, Past President of the Congregation Council and a past member of the property committee. A 1963 Bachelor of Science graduate of Shippensburg University, where he later earned his Masters in Communication. He taught in Mechanicsburg from 1963 to 1967. In 1967, he began teaching at Faust Jr. H.S. where he ran the Audio Visual Club and scored the basketball games, retiring in 1997. For 25 years, he worked at Total Energy, first working part time over the summer, then later as full time; also managing to run the Pine Haven Christmas Tree Farm. Jerry's hobbies were many and varied; in addition to his fascination and collection of trains, he was well known in the area as the local "weatherman" for reporting the weather for the Public Opinion, Herald Mail and WGAL TV. He is survived by his wife, Kathy P. Ashway; a daughter, Betsy Duffie of Hamilton, OH; two sons: Andy Ashway (wife, Karen); John Ashway (girlfriend, Marcy); five grandchildren: Atley and Ella Ashway, Bailey, Bronwyn and Bennett Duffie; two brothers: Denton B. Ashway of Atlanta, GA and Edward L. Ashway of Venice, FL. A memorial service will be held at 1:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 30, 2015 at Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church with the Rev. Dr. Neal O.
