



## Leon F Brennan

August 5, 1920 - July 8, 2017

Leon "Lee" F. Brennan, 96 formally of St. Thomas, passed away on Saturday, July 8, 2017 at Penn Hall. He was born August 5, 1920 in Philadelphia PA, the son of the late William E. and Olivia (DeHans) Brennan. He was a member of Corpus Christi Catholic Church and the American Legion in St. Thomas. Lee attended La Salle University in Philadelphia where he majored in accounting. He served in the Army Air Corps during World War II in the South Pacific Theater where he was attached to the 6th Night Fighter Squadron. He retired from the Defense Department after 30 years and traveled extensively in the US and overseas as a regional maintenance representative in nuclear weapons. After his federal service Lee served as secretary treasurer of E. F. Goetz and Sons Construction Corporation for 12 years. He is survived by several nieces, nephews, great nieces and nephews and life long friends, Jim and Mary Alice Eaton. He was preceded in death by his wife Anna Marie (Moses) Brennan (August 26, 2000) and two brothers: Thomas and William Brennan. There will be a Mass of the Christian Burial held at 11 am on Monday, July 17, 2017 at Corpus Christi Catholic Church. The viewing will be at 10:30 am prior to the service.
