March 5, 1957 - March 15, 2023

MaryAnn Warren, 66, passed away on Tuesday, March 15, 2023 at home after a brief illness. She was born March 5, 1957 in Scranton.

MaryAnn married Thomas Warren on February 11, 1978, and went on to have two children.

MaryAnn graduated from Forest City Regional High School. She was an active volunteer in the community who served on the Blue Ridge Parks Association, was a member of St. Mark's Episcopal Church in New Milford, and served as Pack 90 Cub Scout Master for many years after her sons graduated from Cub Scouts. She dedicated her life to public service serving on the New Milford Borough Council, she was recognized with a distinguished service award from the Pennsylvania State Conservation Commission after her service as President of the Pennsylvania Association of Conservation Districts, received the John J. Baldi Award in 2019 from the Susquehanna Lackawanna BHI DEI Program for her work on behavioral health and intellectual disability issues, and served as Susquehanna County Commissioner for 16 years.

MaryAnn is survived by her husband Thomas Warren, her two sons Bradley and Matthew, and daughter-in-law Ally Warren.

Services will be private and a celebration of life ceremony will be held at a later date.
