Maxine Bonita (Zepp) Shull, 75, of Chambersburg passed away Jan. 10, 2017 at the Chambersburg Hospital. Born on Mar. 27, 1941 in Rohrsville, Md., she was the daughter of the late Rev. Jacob and Ruth Zepp.

A 1959 graduate of Big Spring High School, she attended Messiah College and later graduated from Shippensburg University in 1964.
