Maynard William Franklin Burkett, 91, of Chambersburg, passed away on Sunday, Sept 27, 2015 at the Chambersburg Hospital. He was born February 1, 1924 in Mason Dixon (Greencastle area)PA, the son of the late LLOYD McClellan and Ada Susan Caroline (Daley) Burkett. He worked at and later became a co-owner with his brother in law, Ragan Harbaugh, of the Farmer's Produce for 74 years. A long time resident of the Greencastle area, he was a "coonhunter" and enjoyed attending gun drawings. Maynard was a member for 23 years with the PA Fish Commission, a lifetime member of the Chambersburg Rod and Gun Club, the Chambersburg Moose Lodge #842, the Franklin Fire Co. and a member of AARP local #2287.
