



Megan S Smiley (Kipf)

Megan S. Smiley, 85, of Chambersburg passed away on Mon., Aug. 3, 2015 at the Chambersburg Hospital. Born Sep. 23, 1929 in Santa Ana, CA, she was the daughter of the late Oscar and Nina (Stuart) Kipf. Megan was active in the community her entire life. As a teenager in Santa Ana during WW II, she served in the Coastal Watch as a plane spotter. Megan was a graduate of Santa Ana HS and went on to receive her BA in education from UCLA in 1951. Always a teacher with her children at home and classes at school, Megan taught first grade in Santa Ana, CA and Alexandria, VA. Megan taught Sunday School at Northminster Presbyterian Church in Tucson, AZ and The Presbyterian Congregation in Middletown, PA where she and Deane were members before moving to the Chambersburg area. While in Middletown, Megan worked as a gallery consultant at Moyer's Art gallery in Camp Hill. She was a long time member of The Presbyterian Church of Falling Spring where she was a Sunday School teacher and volunteered for various women's committees. She was a long time member of PEO and the American Rose Society of Chambersburg. Megan enjoyed knitting, crocheting, sewing, art (including creating her own paintings with pastels, oils, and acrylics, pen and ink), and also worked to save wildlife. She is survived by two sons; Robert D. Smiley III (Donna) and Andrew D. Smiley, one daughter; Priscilla O'Donnell (Robert), five grandchildren; Christopher A. Smiley, Justin A. Smiley, Jeffrey M. O'Donnell, Sean S. O'Donnell, and Grace A. O'Donnell, three great grandchildren; Kinsey L. Smiley, Ainsley I. Smiley, and Cameron D. Smiley. In

addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband; R. Deane Smiley Jr. (2008) and a sister, Nina L. (Kipf) Young.
