Nancy Louise Christman, 80, passed away at home on Saturday, September 7, 2024, surrounded by her family. She was born on August 28, 1944, in her grandparents' home (an old schoolhouse) in the village of Williamson, PA.

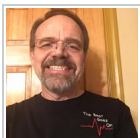
