



## Nancy Van Buskirk

January 21, 1931 - October 4, 2015

Nancy O. Van Buskirk, 84, widow of the late Dr. G.P. Van Buskirk, died Sunday, October 4 at Menno-Haven Nursing Home. She had been in failing health for some time. Nancy, a lifelong resident of Chambersburg, was born on January 21, 1931, the daughter of the late Fred and Lettie Statler Overcash. She graduated from Chambersburg High School in 1949 and helped to plan the class reunions up to and including the 66th, which was held on October 3, 2015. She was a member of Zion Reformed Church, formerly a 50 year member of Heidelberg Church in Marion. Following the death of her husband in January 1979, Nancy became active in multiple service organizations. She volunteered with the local Salvation Army for many decades and Co- Chaired the Fabric Fair for several years. She was on the Advisory Committee of the Franklin County Foundation, and a member of the Shook Home Auxiliary. Nancy was a supporter of the Chambersburg Hospital from the time of her marriage. A lifelong sports enthusiast she rallied for Ohio State Football, the Green Bay Packers, Philadelphia Phillies and PGA golf even through her final illness. She is survived by two sisters, Winifred O. Helman of Chambersburg and Jane O. Aldridge of Waynesboro, a niece, Karen H. (Herb) Harr of Paoli, PA and a nephew, Michael L. Aldridge of Laguna Beach, CA. and a grandnephew, Stephen Harr.
