Born March 3, 1934, in Chambersburg, Polly was the daughter of the late J. Paul Heck and Margaret (Kriner). Polly was a graduate of Chambersburg High School and proud member of Chambersburg High School class of "53".

On December 5, 1954, Polly married Kenneth W. Oyler at Zion Reformed UCC where she attended and was confirmed in her youth.
