March 11, 1933 - March 26, 2017

Paul William "Bill" Peters, 84, of Chambersburg, passed away on Sunday, March 26, 2017 at the Chambersburg Hospital. He was born March 11, 1933 in Shippensburg, PA, the son of the late Paul F. and Virginia G. (Pomeroy) Peters. He was a member of St. John's United Church of Christ. Bill graduated from C.H.S. in 1951 and then from Shippensburg College in 1955 with a B.S. in Education and received his Masters of Education in 1972. He taught at Fayetteville Elementary for 38 years, several of which he was also principal. He served in the U.S. Army, first active duty and then in the Reserves. He enjoyed hunting and fishing, but flower and vegetable gardening was a passion for him. He is survived by his wife of 59 years, Roberta "Bobbie" Ann (Harrison) Peters; two daughters: Lisa Kaye Hoover (Brenton), Beth Ann Rensch (Neilan); three granddaughters: Ashley Nicole and Kerri Rachelle Hoover, Heather Renee Rensch; a brother, Gary L. Peters and four sisters: Patricia A. LaMancuso, Linda K. Seilhamer, Karen D. Fittery, Sandra P. McGehee and several nieces and nephews. The funeral service will be at 11:00 a.m. on Friday, March 31, 2017 at the William F. Sellers Funeral Home with the Rev. Robert Macfarlane officiating.
