June 7, 1943 - April 21, 2022

Peggy Sue DeWire, 78, passed away April 21, 2022 with her daughter by her side at Providence Place in Chambersburg. Born in Chambersburg, June 7, 1943, she was the daughter of the late Joseph and Martha (Eckels) Feldman.

She was a 1961 graduate of CASHS and took classes at Moody Bible Institute. She retired in 2000 after working at Corning for over 30 years. Prior to that she worked at TB Woods and Mack Truck. She was a member of Antrim Brethren In Christ Church.

Ms. DeWire was guided by her faith and dedicated her life to helping others. In the 1980's and 90's, she was a volunteer counselor for Women in Need and founded a nonprofit organization, Friends of Jesus, which provided annual Christmas dinners at the Greencastle Senior Center for those in need. In more recent years, she managed the Greencastle Food Pantry and volunteered for Samaritan's Purse. She enjoyed knitting, crochet, reading, and interior design, but her favorite pastime was spending time with her daughter's family and attending her grandchildren's activities.

Peggy is survived by her beloved daughter Melissa Bard of Greencastle; a granddaughter, Natasha (Mrs. Jesse) Lenharr of Greencastle; a grandson, Trevor (husband of Arielle) Bard of Greencastle; a step-grandson, Tracey Bard, Jr. of Long Beach CA; a great-granddaughter, McKinlee Ryder; a great-

grandson, Beckett Ryder; a sister Martha Joyce Banzhof of Chambersburg; a brother Charles E. Feldman (husband of Cindy) of Greencastle.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her brother J. Kurt Feldman.
