Phyllis Christman Frank, of Chambersburg, PA, died on Sunday, May 3, 2026, in the Chambersburg Hospital after a brief illness. Born July 7, 1933, Phyllis was 92 years old.

Born in Franklin County to the late Ambrose Grove Christman and Margaret Bishop Christman, she attended Chambersburg Senior High School where she graduated in 1951. Throughout the years, Phyllis worked various jobs including for the United Telephone Company, Tracey Fashions, and, most recently, GStek at Letterkenny Army Depot. Phyllis retired at the age of 80 years old.

Known for her work ethic, sense of humor, and wisdom, Phyllis enjoyed listening to the sounds of the waves at the beach, drinking a margarita on her birthday, watching the birds in her backyard, cheering on televised college basketball, and singing along to the music of a mariachi band. She was
