Richard M. Scotti, 75, passed away on Saturday, October 9, 2021 in Chambersburg. He was born September 11, 1946 in Norristown, son of the late Gennaro and Marie (Shamski) Scotti.

Richard was a long-time member of the American Legion and a lifetime member of the Sons of Italy. He served in the Army during Vietnam performing signals intelligence with the Army Security Agency (ASA) in Alaska, Vietnam and Germany.

A Casework Manager, he retired from the PA Department of Public Welfare after many years. In the early 1990s he worked to institute the welfare-to-work program in Montgomery Co.
