



## Robert D. Snyder

May 18, 1919 - October 8, 2013

Robert D. Snyder 94, of Chambersburg passed away on Tuesday, October 08, 2013 at Providence Place. He was born on Sunday, May 18, 1919 in Chambersburg, PA the son of the late David and Myra Flack Snyder. He was a lifelong member of Trinity Lutheran Church where he was a Sunday school teacher for Men's Class, an usher and a Home Visitor. As a young man, Robert farmed the Borough Farm and rented farm land. He won an award for the best alfalfa crop.

He served in the Army during World War II before going to work at the Heinz Co. where he was Chief of Power from 1945 to 1952 and then Superintendent of Boiler and Heat for Letterkenny Army Depot from 1952 until he retired in 1979. He is survived by his daughter, Barbara (Mrs. Eric) Kreyll and son, Robert Snyder, both of Chambersburg; his former daughter-in-law and friend Sandy Snyder, Shippensburg; four grandchildren: Sheryl Greenwald, Hagerstown, MD; Kenneth Sterner, Boonsboro, MD; Bobbie Stine, David Sterner, both of Chambersburg; and eleven great grandchildren. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife Hilda E. Snyder, a brother, Richard F. Snyder and a sister; Mary (Snyder) Miley.
