Robin LaRue Swank, 69, of Chambersburg, died late Friday afternoon, January 13, 2023, at WellSpan Chambersburg Hospital.

Born September 25, 1953, in Chambersburg, she was a daughter of the late Charles Eugene and Violet Mae Woods Swank. She attended school in St. Thomas and graduated from James Buchanan High School, Mercersburg. Robin had worked previously with Staples Warehouse, Chambersburg, Raskas Cheese Products, Shippensburg, and Carlisle Tire and Rubber. As a young woman, she worked in a grocery store in Mercersburg.
