



## Ronald William Reinhardt

Ronald Reinhardt, a dedicated husband, a loving father, and a very special Poppop, passed away peacefully on April 2nd, 2018 at the Chambersburg Hospital surrounded by his family. He was born June 29th, 1936 in Ridgewood, New York to his father and mother, Peter and Rose Reinhardt. Ronald "Ron" Reinhardt graduated from Grover Cleveland High School in 1954 and married his wife, Barbara, on May 29, 1960.
