Roy C. Cramer, 96, of Chambersburg went to be with the Lord on Wednesday, December 31, 2014 at Chambersburg Hospital. Born in Chambersburg, he was the son of the late Robert and Amanda Cramer. Roy served in the U.S. Army for nine years and was active during the beginning and end of WWII, serving in the Pacific Theatre of operations which included the attack on Pearl Harbor and retaking of the Islands from Guadal Canal and the Luzons, Phillipines. Upon discharge he returned to Chambersburg, where he worked at Letterkenny until retirement. He was a devoted member of First United Methodist Church. Roy is survived by his daughter, Barbara D. (Mrs. Walter) Armstrong, Chambersburg; two grandchildren; four great grandchildren and one great great grandchild. He was preceded in death by his wife Learie Graves; eight brothers and sisters.

Graveside services will be held at 1:30 pm on Monday, January 5, 2015 at Norland Cemetery with the Rev. Dr. Diane Salter officiating. Military honors are provided by VFW Post #1599.
