March 11, 1942 - May 18, 2014

Stanley Richard Kremp, 72, of Chambersburg, passed away on May 18, 2014 in Golden, Colorado. He was born March 11, 1942 in Harrisburg, PA, the son of the late John Richard and June Marie (Upperman) Kremp. He was a graduate of both Chambersburg Area Senior High School and Gettysburg College and was employed for 30 years with IBM as a systems engineer/manager. After retirement, he was a consultant at the Army research Lab. On September 2, 1967 he married Sylvia Marie (Dix) Kremp in Oxon Hill, Maryland. He was a member of Phi Sigma Kappa fraternity at college, member of the Boy Scouts of America Order of the Arrow; BSA Waterfront instructor and director at Camp Mahonegon, Ellamore, WV; cub scout Webelos leader, Paris, France and organizer of the BSA Explorer Computer Post 360, Hagerstown, MD. He was also past president and treasurer of the Unitarian Universalist Church of Hagerstown, MD, a board member of the Washington County Mental Health Center, member of the Lancaster (PA) Liederkrantz German-American Club and a drummer in the Shippensburg (PA) Blaskapelle German Band. In addition to his wife, he is survived by his two sons: Timothy Upperman Kremp and Tyler Lowry Kremp; three grandchildren: Devi Kremp and Arianna and Kalin Peters; maternal aunt, Mrs. Annie L. Gift and six cousins: Edward L. Gift, Jeffrey A. Gift, Susan M. Bobb, Rodney M. Miller, Staci L. Pheil and Kelly S. Upperman.
