



## Terry Paul Grove

June 12, 1961 - November 24, 2022

Terry Paul Grove, 61, passed away Thursday, November 24, 2022 at Chambersburg Hospital. He was born June 12, 1961 in Chambersburg, the son of the late Betty (Bryan) and Richard Grove.

Graduated from Scotland School for Veterans Children in 1979. Terry was very athletic and spent many years playing different sports, including basketball, wrestling, track and cross country. He had a lifelong love of sports and continued to play them in later years including softball, but he is known for his love of golf.

Upon graduation he went into the US Army. Upon his return from Germany, he picked up and continued sharing his love of sports by coaching youth football and basketball. This love of working with children and youth continued when he went to work at the Children's Aid Society. He was employed for 13 years there and had an immense impact on the kids that he spent time with.

He was a long time Post member of the Chambersburg American Legion Post 46, American Legion Riders Chapter 46, Scotland Country Club Golf League and a member of the Knights of Columbus Dart Club.

In addition to playing and coaching sports, his favorite teams were Notre Dame and any Detroit Team. Terry and Irma enjoyed going dancing, listening

to country music, being out of doors and especially riding his motorcycle.

Terry was altruistic in nature and showed this throughout his life by working with the youth sports. He also supported his sister, Joy, who was battling breast cancer, also others who are fighting this disease, by accompanying her to the Pink Zone State College Women's Basketball Game. He was a strong man and fought gallantly for four years before succumbing to cancer.

Terry is survived by his long time companion of 18 years, Irma Dile; five siblings: Joy Smith (Terry), Joyce Knoll, Darryl Grove, Jacquelyn Grove (Steve), Ronald (Nancy) Grove, nine grandchildren, numerous nieces, nephews and cousins.

In addition to his parents and brother Donald, Terry is preceded in death by his twin brother Jerry.

Funeral services will be held at 1:00 PM on Tuesday, December 6, 2022 at Sellers Funeral Home with Pastor Andy Ficks officiating. There will be a viewing from 6-8:00 PM on Monday, December 5, 2022 and one hour prior to the service on Tuesday. Burial will be in Parklawns Memorial Gardens.
