Walter Lee Armstrong, 60, died Wednesday, March 4, 2015, at 9:40 p.m. at the Chambersburg Hospital following a 21 month battle with Lung Cancer. Walter was born to Dorothy and John Armstrong the 26th of October 1954, at the U. S. Naval Hospital in Philadelphia, PA. He is survived by his wife Barbara (Cramer) Armstrong, his son, Harley Armstrong, and his daughters, Wendy and Nicole Armstrong.
