William E. Fluke, 93, of Upper Strasburg passed away Thursday, December 15, 2016 at the Chambersburg Hospital. He was born September 12, 1923 in Hopewell PA, the son of the late Lamont and Barbara (Hoover) Fluke. He graduated from Altoona H.S., attended the Otterbein United Methodist Church of Newburg was a Boy Scout leader and a member of the Newburg and Orrstown Masonic Lodges.
